The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of the petitioner being eligible as per provisions of the Punjab Travel Professional's Regulation Act, 2012 and the rules framed thereunder for issuance of license for doing work of Visa Consultancy/IELTS Centre, yet, the application dated 7.9.2017 before the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar is still pending.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sahil Sharma, learned D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 and waives service. A complete copy of the writ paper book already stands furnished to learned State counsel.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case an application has been submitted by the petitioner before the competent authority, the same would be processed in accordance with law and as per provisions of the Punjab Travel Professional's Regulation Act, 2012 and the rules framed thereunder and a final decision in regard thereto would be taken and conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two months from today.
