Further prayer is to conduct fair and independent inquiry in FIR No.0051 dated 06.06.2018, under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Bhadson (Patiala).

At the outset, learned State Counsel, on instructions from the police official present in the Court, has pointed out that after trial, petitioner stands acquitted.

In view of above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
