These three petitions have been decided vide this common
order as facts and law involved therein are same.

These three petitions have been filed for quashing of the

impugned portion of the order dated 14.8.2018 thereby imposing a condition of furnishing Bank draft or Bank Guarantee or FDR in favour of the complainant for an amount of half of the value of cheque.

It has been stated that composite compromise has taken place between the parties as per which the three appeals (out of which the present petitions arise) could be decided and those matters are kept for 1.7.2019 for the petitioner to make payments.

In this view of the matter, the present petitions have been rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.

Since the main cases has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed as such.
