1. The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.304 dated 07.07.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station DLF Phase-I, Gurugram, District Gurugram.
2. Reply filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Karan Goel, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, DSL, Gurugram on behalf of respondent No.1 is taken on record.
3. At the time of issuance of notice, it had been represented that a compromise has been entered into between the parties and that a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is likely to filed.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has today informed that petition

bearing CRM-M-41560-2018 has been filed for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise dated 10.09.2018 and statements of parties have already recorded by the trial Court as regards the factum of compromise.

5. Learned State counsel has informed that the petitioners have already joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation.
6. In view of the aforestated factual position wherein parties are stated to have entered into a compromise, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 10.09.2018 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
