ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 41 dated 12.03.2019, under Sections 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 ('NDPS Act'-for short) registered at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been roped in the instant case on the basis of statement of Sunil from whom 12 grams of *smack* was recovered. The petitioner is a lady with three minor children and is not involved in any other case under NDPS Act.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by order dated 16.04.2019 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 16.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
