This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.612 dated 11.10.2018 registered under Section 435 IPC (Sections 409/420 & 203 IPC added later on during investigation) at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the incident took place on 05.08.2015. The inquiry report was submitted on 06.06.2018 but the FIR was lodged on 11.10.2018. Even as per the inquiry report no financial irregularity has been found and the petitioner has been in custody for more than 1 ½ months.

Custody certificate dated 01.05.2019 by way of affidavit of

Rakesh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Jind) Haryana on

behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 01 month and 16 days of custody.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
