The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.235 dated 22.08.2017 under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana and all other proceedings arising out of the said F.I.R.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the aforesaid FIR was registered at the behest of respondent No.2 Parminder Kaur, who is mother of respondent No.3 Sharanjeet Kaur. The petitioner and respondent No.3 are staying together as husband and wife and they had also approached this Court vide **CRM-M-31017 of 2017** titled as ***Jolly and another Versus State of Punjab and others*** seeking protection of their life and liberty. Vide order dated 23.08.2017 passed in that petition, this Court had directed

Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to ensure that their life and liberty is not breached.

Learned State counsel has informed this Court that after registration of the FIR, the police has conducted investigation and has prepared a cancellation report, which is pending consideration for onward submission to the trial Court.

In view of the aforesaid fact, when the police has already prepared a cancellation report and the same is in the process of presentation before the Court, this Court finds that the present petition is rendered infructuous at this stage.

Dismissed as infructuous at this stage.

However, in case the petitioner finds that the cancellation report is presented to the Court and the same is not accepted there, he shall be at liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of the aforesaid FIR on merits.
