This order shall dispose off a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 460 dated 26.11.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 and 34 IPC Police Station Shahbad, District Kurukshetra on the basis of compromise.

Report dated 22.05.2018 of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Shahabad has been received whereby after recording joint statement of complainant Naina Paruthi and accused persons, namely, Vikram Paruthi, Mrs. Promilla Paruthi, Mrs. Kavita Arora and Mrs. Meenu Kochar, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure

Private parties to this petition have also put in appearance

and during the course of interaction with the parties, it transpired that they have compromised the matter and resolved to end the dispute.

Heard.

In the light of joint statement made by the parties and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 460 dated 26.11.2014 registered at Police Station Shahbad, Kurukshetra under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 and 34 IPC, District Kurukshetra and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners is quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
