This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 323, 324 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 325, 326 and 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 23.04.2019 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that after investigation in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017, the petitioner was found innocent during trial proceedings. The Court has proceeded to pass an order under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning the petitioner as an additional accused.

Notice of motion for 23.05.2019.

Let the petitioner appear before the learned trial Court on or before 25.04.2019 i.e. the date fixed and upon his appearance, learned trial Court shall admit him on interim regular bail.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends in compliance of the order dated 23.04.2019, petitioner has put an appearance before trial Court and furnished the bail bonds. This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Jasbir Singh.

Considering the above, and the fact that the petitioner in compliance of order dated 23.04.2019, is on interim regular bail by trial Court, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Court to make an application for absolute regular bail.

Petition is disposed off.
