Present petition was filed with following substantive prayers:-

“It is therefore, most respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and necessary direction may kindly be issued to official respondents to carry out fair and impartial investigation and submit status report in criminal case bearing FIR No.128 dated 21.7.2017 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Kharar, District Mohali (SAS Nagar).

It is further prayed that direction may be issued to the respondent No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, so that she may not become a victim of continuous oppression and violence inflicted upon her by the accused persons and deliberates inaction and sadness of State Police Mechanism as she is being pressurized at the behest of the accused persons by the local police to

compromise the matter as otherwise threats are being given that she will be implicated in some false criminal cases.

It is further prayed that direction may be issued to the respondent No.1 and 2 to handover the investigation of case FIR No.128 dated 21.7.2017 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Kharar, District Mohali (SAS Nagar) to some independent Investigating Agency and it may further be directed that the investigation be supervised by some Senior IPS rank officer as the local police is deliberately giving shielding to the accused persons due to ulterior motives, in the interest of justice and equity.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, has submitted that after completion of the investigation, challans against some of the accused were presented on 08.12.2018 whereas against Randhir Singh, challan has been presented on 15.07.2019.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, petitioner is relegated to the remedy before the trial Court.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
