FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 23.10.2018 of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kalka has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent/complainant-Seema Rani and accused/petitioners, namely, Jaswinder Singh, balbir Singh, Surender Kaur and Sukhdarshan Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have vouched for the settlement that has been arrived at between them and prayed that the matter be quashed on the basis of compromise/settlement (Annexure P-2) and shall abide by the

same.

Heard.

In the light of joint statement made by the parties and together with the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 274 dated 12.12.2014 under Sections 323/406/498-A/506/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
