Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.15 dated 11.02.2019 registered under Section 379-A(1) of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station GRP Rohtak District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. He submits that allegations of snatching are from employee of Railway Protection Force (Railway Police). He further submitted that the petitioner was earlier also falsely implicated which has resulted into acquittal i.e. in FIR No.259/2015 vide judgment dated 20.04.2019.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Karanveer Singh, has submitted that the petitioner is involved in another FIR i.e. 37/2017.

A copy of the FIR has been produced in which allegations are for snatching of mobile phone worth ₹2,000/-. In FIR No.37/2017, the trial is pending.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that investigation is complete, challan has been presented and the petitioner is in custody since 12.02.2019, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
