The instant Regular Second Appeal is pending in this Court since 1999. Respondent Nos. 1,2,3,4,8 to 10, 11,13 and 19 were served but as no one appeared on their behalf, they were proceeded against ex-parte vide order dated 06.12.2000. Since respondent Nos. 7 and 12 remained unserved, it was directed to issue fresh notice to them on filing of process fee. Despite several opportunities having been granted to the appellant to furnish the correct address and to file process fee, the same were not supplied by the counsel, as noticed by the Registry and this Court in its order dated 15.01.2019.

Today, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant submits that despite having addressed various communications to the respondents, there is no response from them and he pleads no instructions.

Consequently, this appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution, however, in case the appellant does want to agitate the matter, he is at liberty to initiate necessary steps to recall this order within a period of six

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months.
