The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar, Police Station Kheri Pul, Faridabad, submits that petitioners in consequence of order of interim bail dated 30.01.2018, have joined the investigation in this case and does not oppose the grant of relief as nothing is to be recovered from them.

Together with the stand of the two sides that parties have effected a settlement which is reflected from the settlement/agreement dated 13.03.2018, sent to this Court by the Mediator, necessitates making the orders of interim bail absolute.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 30.01.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
