In terms of the orders of this Court dated 13.8.2018, 26.10.2018 and 9.1.2019, this application (CM No.7637-C of 2019) has been filed, seeking to place on record an affidavit of Shri Balbir Singh, Under Secretary to the Government of Punjab, Department of Local Government, stating therein that the address of only one of the legal representatives, i.e. son of the late respondent, Vijay Kumar Goel, could be found out, which is as follows:-

“Vineet Goel son of Vijay Kumar Goel, House NO.16929, Street No.7, Aggarwal Colony, Opposite Keshav Park, Bathinda.”

However, it is further stated that the said house was found to be locked with no one residing there, with no other legal heir having been found by the applicant-appellant, i.e. the State of Punjab.

Ms.Arora has made a very fair and good suggestion to the

effect that in the aforesaid circumstances, even if this appeal is dismissed in default, the State may be given liberty to move an application for reviving it in case any of the legal representatives of the respondent-Decree Holder, i.e. Vijay Kumar Goel, institute execution proceedings.

The appeal is dismissed in default with the aforesaid liberty granted.
