The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.153 dated 25.6.2016 registered at Police Station Parao, Ambala Cantt., District Ambala under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 consequent upon his bail having been cancelled by the learned trial Court on account of his absence on 9.3.2018.

Pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 24.8.2018, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court as is evident from the copy of order dated 29.8.2018 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala, which has been furnished by learned counsel for the petitioner today in Court.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances and bearing in mind the nature of offences, a lenient view is taken and the present petition

stands accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 24.8.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall keep on appearing regularly before the trial Court on each and every date.
