Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for setting aside of the order dated 04.12.2006 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya in case titled as ***State Versus Balraj*** bearing FIR No.102 dated 01.08.2004 under Sections 354, 160 and 510 IPC registered at Police Station GRP Jalandhar, District Hoshiarpur, whereby the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed offender.

Vide order dated 24.04.2019, this Court had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within ten days from that date and on doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by that Court to its satisfaction.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that in case the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court in terms of order dated 24.04.2019 passed by this Court, the order dated

24.04.2019 shall be made absolute. However, in case he has not complied the said order, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-compliance of the order dated 24.04.2019 passed by this Court.
