Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, pending trial, in case FIR No.1 dated 11.06.2018 registered under Sections 306, 34 of IPC at Police Station Handesra, District Mohali.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 11.06.2018. He, while making reference to Annexure P-2, which is a Mutual Agreement signed by the deceased, states that Naresh Kumar Saini resident of City Ambala, was in illicit relations with the deceased and once the petitioner has pointed out this fact to the deceased and her family members, she signed the mutual agreement and a compromise was arrived at between the parties. Thereafter, she committed suicide, leaving suicide note dated 11.06.2018. The trial in the case will take sufficient long time as only 4 witnesses have been examined out of total 16 witnesses.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the custody and the fact that 4 PWs have been examined in the case.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the deceased had died after about 15 years of her marriage and out of the wedlock, two sons, aged 15 years and 13 years, were born, who are residing with the maternal uncle and further, while taking into consideration the nature of allegation made by the petitioner against the deceased, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
