Receipt of ₹1,000/- has been produced.

The criminal complaint filed by the petitioner was dismissed by the learned trial Court refusing to summon the accused finding that the case, as made out, is of civil nature. It has been noticed that the mother of the petitioner had agreed to purchase certain property from accused No.3 and since mother had expired, therefore, the sale deed was executed in favour of sister-in-law of the petitioner i.e. brother's wife and other legal heirs of the mother had no objection. The aforesaid order was also confirmed by the Court of Session while deciding the revision petition.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has made sincere efforts, however, could not persuade this Court to take a different view. The jurisdiction of the Court while entertaining petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is limited. Hence, no ground is made out.
