filed by petitioner-Amritpal Singh @ Golu and CRM-M-17877-2019,
filed by petitioner-Boota Singh @ Buta, for grant of regular bail in case
FIR No.123 dated 04.08.2018, registered at Police Station Goraya,

District Jalandhar, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners were granted interim bail on 15.09.2018 and thereafter, when the CFSL report was received, their interim bail was cancelled and they surrendered before the trial Court on 02.01.2019. The petitioners are now in custody for the last one year.

Learned State counsel on the instructions from ASI Gurdev Lal submits that challan has been presented and out of 11 prosecution witnesses, only 02 have been examined.

The trial would take time to conclude. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in custody.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case of either side, both these petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate.
