The petitioner is seeking cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.2 in FIR No.16 dated 25.4.2018, under Sections 302, 148, 149, 201 IPC and 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was involved in a case registered under Section 302 IPC and she was granted regular bail but after the grant of regular bail, respondent No.2 Manjit Kaur has been threatening the witnesses.

Heard.

The allegations against respondent No.2 Manjit Kaur in the FIR are that she is alleged to have raised *lalkara*. No injury is attributed to her.

There is no material on record which would suggest that respondent No.2

had threatened the witnesses and has misused the concession of bail in any manner. Consequently, I do not find any infirmity in the order granting regular bail to respondent No.2, therefore, the petition stands dismissed.
