Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to require and obligate the respondent to accept the offer of the petitioners for redemption of the mortgage and to release the documents of title upon receipt of the mortgage debt alongwith upto date interest from the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the bank for the relief claimed in the writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
