The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.169 dated 23.3.2019, registered under Sections 406 and 506 IPC at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram.

Vide order dated 16.4.2019, interim bail was granted to the petitioner on the specific undertaking of the petitioner that he will pay the amount of Rs.10 lakhs along with reasonable interest to the complainant. Thereafter, the case had been adjourned 3 times. However, till today, the amount has not been paid.

On a specific query whether the petitioner has brought the draft today, learned counsel for the petitioner, who is being instructed by the petitioner, present in Court, submits that he has not brought the draft even today.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, which shall hamper the fair investigation by the police.

Dismissed.
