Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for safeguarding the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of the respondents No.4 to 8 by issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 and further for issuance of directions to not to implicate them into any false case, as both the petitioners have a love affair and are living in a live in relationship and could not marry as age of petitioner No.2 is less than 21 years and it being against the consent of respondents No.4 to 8.

For the relief claimed in this petition the petitioners have also moved a representation dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) and at this stage they would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
