Criminal Misc. No.M-17580 of 2019:

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the

petitioner in case FIR No.72 dated 30.03.2019 under Sections 376 IPC and Section 67 IT Act registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 18.04.2019, this Court has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC and his joining investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties and a compromise deed dated 18.07.2019 has been reduced into writing.

Mr. Umesh Sharma, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant-respondent no.2 and does not dispute the factum of compromise so arrived between the parties.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that since compromise has been effected between the petitioner and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 18.04.2019 is made absolute, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- each by the petitioner and complainant, which shall be paid to All India Pingalwara Charitable Society, G.T.Road Amritsar.
