In the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 & 5, who are father and brother of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 12.04.2019 as per Sikh Rites and Ceremonies at Gurudwara Guru Nanak Niwas, village Karor Kalan, Tehsil Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali). The photographs of the marriage and marriage certificate have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 06.12.1998 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the year of birth of petitioner No.2 is 1993 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 12.04.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Avinit Avasthi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied to him.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
