The present petition has been filed for grant of emergency parole to the petitioner to perform the last rites/rituals of his father, who is stated to be died on 11.4.2019.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Sewa Singh, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Rohtak dated 20.4.2019 as filed in Court is taken on record. The only reason for rejecting the parole of the petitioner is cited as modal code of conduct due to General Elections of Lok Sabha being in force by Election Commission.

Hence, it is not disputed that the father of the petitioner has died on 11.4.2019 and the last rites/rituals have to be performed on 24.4.2019.

In view of the above, this Court deems it appropriate to allow the petitioner to be released on emergency parole for one week commencing from 23.4.2019 subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹ 1 lac each with two sureties in the like amount, one of which shall be of close family member and any other condition to be imposed by the District Magistrate, Jhajjar to his satisfaction. The petitioner shall surrender back

does not report back on 30.4.2019, the Jail Superintendent, Rohtak shall inform this Court immediately by way of an affidavit to be listed before this Court along with the present petition.

The petition stands allowed as above.
