1. The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.24 dated 5.3.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, Police Station Khanna, District Ludhiana.
2. During the proceeding of this petition, the parties were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court which has yielded results and the parties have amicably resolved their issues and shall be filing a petition for dissolution of marriage by mutual consent. A copy of settlement agreement dated 25.9.2019 shows that the parties have also agreed for getting the present FIR quashed.
3. The aforestated position is admitted to be correct by learned counsel

representing the complainant.

4. In view of the aforesaid position, where the parties have amicably resolved the issues, the petition, is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 18.4.2019 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
