The punishment regarding offences involved in the FIR is upto seven years, in view of the ratio decidendi culled out by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar and another, 2014 (3) RCR (Criminal) 527**. The petitioner cannot be said to have an apprehension of threat as there is a separate procedure regarding compliance of the provisions of Section 41 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave of the Court for withdrawal of the present petition.
