Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to conduct the inquiry/investigation on the complaint dated 11.06.2018 submitted by the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Superintendent of Police, Ambala is on record. In this reply, it is stated that on receiving the complaint, an inquiry was conducted, in which it was found that one Balbir Singh has purchased the share of his cousin Gurlabh Singh, measuring 03 marlas of land vide sale deed No.4254 dated 11.01.2000 and mutation of the land was sanctioned on 12.04.2006. Thereafter, Balbir Singh transferred 03 marlas of land in favour of his wife Jasbir Kaur through a Civil Court decree dated 30.03.2013 and again mutation was sanctioned on 06.08.2013. During the

inquiry, it was found that FIR No.46 dated 16.02.2016 under Section 420 IPC, Police Station Ambala City was got registered by Balbir Singh against his brothers Gurbhag Singh (petitioner), Gurbachan Singh and his cousins Gurlabh Singh and Param Pal Singh, in which they are facing the trial and the same is pending before the competent Court at Ambala. It is further stated that in the inquiry, it was concluded that there is no substance in the complaint, in view of the aforesaid Civil Court decree and accordingly, the same was filed on 18.09.2018.

Accordingly, this petition is rendered as infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for redressal of his grievance, if any.
