GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. ASI Ranjit Singh is present in person and has furnished an affidavit of Inspector Dalbir Singh, State Crime Branch, Faridabad wherein he has deposed that upon verification it has been found that the marriage of daughter of petitioner is indeed to be solemnized on 28.4.2019. It has also been deposed therein that statement of one Habib Khan had been recorded as per which in case the petitioner is released on interim bail, there is apprehension of quarrel.
2. In view of the aforestated affidavit and also bearing in mind the fact that the trial Court has already partly allowed the application for

grant of interim bail by directing the petitioner to attend marriage of his daughter while in custody, the petition is dismissed.

3. It is however directed that when the petitioner is taken to attend his daughter's marriage on 28.04.2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m, he shall be accompanied by policemen in civil dress and not in uniform. The police official shall keep a constant vigil on the petitioner while also ensuring that no embarrassment is caused to him on account of presence of the police officials.
4. The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid clarification.
5. It is however clarified that the entire expenses for the transportation etc. shall be borne by the petitioner/petitioner's family.
