On 22.04.2019, following order was passed:-

“Rajwinder Kaur and Parvinder Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs (Annexures P-4) evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 16.04.2019 (Annexure P- 5) to respondent No.2.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab, is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State Counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to

the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violating of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 26.04.2019.”

In response to the aforesaid order, status report along with statements of the petitioners as also of respondent nos. 4 to 6 has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

Keeping in view the status report, the present petition is disposed of. However, petitioners would be at liberty to move fresh application, in case, they feel that there is any apprehension to their life and liberty.
