Prayer in this petition is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner, in FIR No.357 dated 20.11.2018 under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sector-26, Chandigarh, on the ground that his wife is pregnant and her expected date of delivery is 04.05.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the OPD slips of Govt. Multi Specialty Hospital, Sector-16, Chandigarh and PGIMER, Chandigarh to submit that wife of the petitioner is suffering from '*seizure disorder*' as it is a case of infertility, where she has conceived after 08 years of marriage and there is no one in the family to take care of his wife and prays for interim bail for a period of three weeks. It is submitted that two co-accused namely Rohit Bhardwaj @ Rimmy and Rajesh Kumar have already been

granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide orders dated 08.03.2019 and 20.03.2019.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh could not dispute the factual position.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of three weeks, subject to furnishing his bail bond and heavy surety, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities on 23.05.2019 before 5.00 p.m.

Petition is disposed of.
