By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.83 dated 2.6.2015 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur under Section 336 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 1.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dhuri has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Parmveer Singh @ Pamma, Manmeet Singh, Jaspreet Singh @ Jassi, Vicky @ Paramjit Singh and Punarveer Singh and also of complainant Hartinder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dhuri that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.83 dated 2.6.2015 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur under Section 336 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
