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**SANJAY KUMAR, J. (Oral)**

The prayer of the petitioners in this case was to direct the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, to call them for interview for the post of UDC pursuant to the Advertisement No.3/2016 dated 20.02.2016 (Annexure P-1).

By order dated 22.04.2019 passed in this writ petition, this Court directed that the petitioners should be provisionally interviewed and that their results should be kept in a sealed cover. Pursuant to the later order dated 12.09.2019 passed in this writ petition, Mr. Hitesh Pandit, learned counsel for respondent No.2-Commission, produced the results of the petitioners in a sealed cover today. The same is perused and returned to him. A copy thereof shall be furnished to the other side. In terms of the

result, the first petitioner (General Category) secured 94 marks; the second petitioner (BCA Category) secured 96 marks, the third petitioner (General Category) secured 107 marks; the 4<sup>th</sup> petitioner (General Category) secured 112 marks, the fifth petitioner (BCB Category) secured 74 marks, the sixth petitioner (BCB Category) secured 85 marks; and the 7<sup>th</sup> petitioner (General Category) secured 115 marks. As the petitioners only sought relief to the extent of being interviewed for the subject post and such relief has already been extended to them by virtue of the interim order passed in this writ petition, their grievance in this writ petition stands settled.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of leaving it open to the petitioners to take further steps, if so advised, in relation to their other grievances, if any.
