On 25.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner was named as accused in complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. It has been contended in the petition that the arrest warrants issued against the petitioner were not served upon him but he was declared proclaimed person and direction was issued to get another FIR registered against the petitioner under Section 174 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion for 24.05.2019.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the Court where complaint titled as State Bank of India Vs. Jagga Singh is pending. Petitioner would be at liberty to move an application to grant him concession of regular bail and if such an application is filed, the Court would release the petitioner on regular bail. However, before granting bail, petitioner would be required to give undertaking that he would appear in the Court as and when

called upon.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with the order, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and released on regular bail and the petitioner is regularly appearing in the Court thereafter.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, since the purpose of declaring proclaimed offender is to secure his presence, therefore, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous once the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and granted bail.
