This is third time when there is a request for an adjournment on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner in a case which is listed in urgent. On 14.05.2019, a written request for an adjournment was filed. On 26.04.2019 also, a written request for an adjournment was filed. On 23.04.2019, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Today again, there is a request for an adjournment, which is declined. Hence, this Court is left with no other option except to decide the present petition.

Petitioner before this Court has prayed for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty as provided under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court in the order passed in **Raj Rani and others Vs State of Punjab and others** (CRM-M-20457-2019, decided on 06.05.2019) has held that the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the petitioner is relegated to the remedy available under law.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
