By this petition, the petitioner has challenged the issuance of non-bailable warrants against him in case FIR No.353, dated 29.4.2016, registered under Sections 7, 8 & 9 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, at Police Station Sadar, Hisar.

At the very outset, learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, points out that the police is not interested in arresting the petitioner for any purpose but the fact of the matter is that charge has been framed against his co-accused and the petitioner is only required to appear before the Court so that a copy of the challan can be handed over to him and further proceedings in the trial can take place.

Counsel for the petitioner has fairly stated that if the purpose is

only this, then the petitioner would appear before the trial Court on the date fixed viz 2.2.2019 to accept the copy of the challan and would not seek benefit of the provisions of Section 45 of the Cr.P.C.

In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with the direction that as per undertaking if the petitioner appears before the trial Court on the date fixed, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
