Petitioners Arun Kumar and Chintu Singh have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.82 dated 03.06.2018, registered at Police Station Payal, Khanna, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, present petitioner Arun Kumar along with his son Chintu Singh has cheated the complainant for more than ₹19 lacs.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners

were the agents of the company and they themselves had invested in the

company.

The petitioners have been in custody since 17.11.2018. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. Offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class. No useful purpose will be served by keeping them in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
