The petitioner was accused in a complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. He was declared proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the parties state that the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act has already been withdrawn and the present FIR is only on account of the fact that he was declared proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above-said fact and situation, if the petitioner is arrested, he would be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
