This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.257 dated 09.07.2017 registered under Sections 15/29 NDPS Act, 1985 & Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused was granted regular bail vide order passed in **CRM-M-8938-2019** dated 09.04.2019 titled as ***Deepak Vs. State of Haryana (Annexure P-11)***.

Custody certificate dated 13.05.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Ram Chander, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Sonipat), Haryana on behalf of State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel

opposite. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year, 10 months & 3 days.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh has accepted that the co-accused has been granted the concession of regular bail by order (Annexure P-11).

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioner and consequently, grant him the concession of regular bail in the same terms as in the above mentioned case.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
