This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.8 dated 22.03.2019 registered under Sections 7, 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at P.S. S.V.B. Karnal, Unit, Jind.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 18.05.2019 by Satyabhan – Dsp, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Jind is taken on record, wherein it has been certified that the petitioner has been in custody for the last 1 month and 27 days as on 18.05.2019.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from other facts the petitioner has been in custody for the last almost 2 months.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has accepted that the petitioner has been in custody for the last almost 2 months.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned C.J.M/Illaqa Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
