Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.558 dated 10.10.2018, registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad, under Sections 379-A, 420, 411 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner alongwith co-accused snatched Rs.76,000/- from the complainant after giving him beatings. In the present case, the

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complainant has already been examined.

The petitioner is in custody since 27.10.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
