The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 2.8.2017 passed by this court in RSA No. 3218 of 2014. The relevant portion of the order is quoted below:

“In the meantime, parties are directed to maintain status quo regarding possession as well as alienation of the suit property.”

There is nothing on record to show that the said order has been wilfully disobeyed. Even at the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner failed to point out the same.

No ground is made out for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents.

Dismissed.
