Learned State counsel submits that out of total eight witnesses, four witnesses have been examined. The petitioner was released on interim bail but he misused the same and was involved in case under Section 326 IPC and one more case under Section 392 IPC is also there against him.

FSL report has been received and the recovery effected from the petitioner is commercial quantity. The next date before the trial Court is fixed for 02.04.2019.

Keeping in view the facts as mentioned above and that the quantity of Narcotic substance is commercial, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to expedite the trial preferably within a period of two months.
