Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.75 dated 01.04.2019 registered under Sections 3, 4, 5 of Immoral Traffic Act, 1956, at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the investigation is complete and challan has been filed. Maximum punishment is three years for the offence which has been alleged against the petitioners, although, it is the stand of the petitioners that they have been falsely implicated.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State has submitted that there are three more cases against petitioner No.1 and one case against petitioner Nos.2 and 3.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the offence is triable by the Magistrate and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds and respective undertakings before the trial Court that in future they would not indulge in such activity and if they are found to have indulged, the bail be cancelled without notice to them, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
