The instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Nuh to look into the matter and submit the status report to the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate within a period of 45 days, who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. And others; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.**
