This revision petition has been filed against the order dated 27.09.2018, passed by Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Jaitu, in execution application, titled 'Punjab & Sind Bank Vs. Mukhtiar Kaur and others'.

Inter alia, it is observed that the plaintiff-Bank had filed a wrong execution application on the basis of preliminary decree dated 21.09.2001, which was not executable. The plaintiff had failed to apply for passing of final decree, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for decree holder that if an opportunity was given to decree holder for applying for passing of final decree, then, the execution application might be disposed of and an opportunity be granted to the decree holder to apply for passing of final decree. Accordingly, the execution application was disposed of, observing that the decree holder was at liberty to apply for passing of final decree.

I do not find any illegality or infirmity in the order, much less apparent on the face of it, which might have called for interference by this Court by exercising revisional jurisdiction. There being no merit in the revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
