In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that he had rendered 7 years, 9 months and 23 days military service and the same be taken into account as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-9) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Nidhi Garg, learned Assistant

Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1

to 3 and Mr. Chander Mohan Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the respondents state that they have no objection for the grant of prayer of the petitioner for deciding the legal notice in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-9) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released in his favour within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
