Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 22.02.2019 registered under Section 376 of IPC at Police Station Jodhewal, Ludhiana.

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Pal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.04.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
